### The O Sensei Revisited Down Under Workshop with Robert Nadeau Shihan, 8th Dan & Richard Moon Sensei, 6th Dan, Guest Teacher

**Robert Nadeau Shihan, 8<sup>th</sup> Dan**, has trained and influenced several generations of Aikido teachers in America, Europe, New Zealand, Russia and Israel. In the 1960's he studied **as a personal student of Aikido founder Morihei Ueshiba (O Sensei)**, receiving personal instruction from O Sensei in the spiritual, philosophical and energy aspects of Aikido.

"The inner work of O Sensei should not be lost" says Robert Nadeau Shihan, Experience 'The O Sensei Process of Development' shared by Shihan Nadeau, through direct practice, techniques and discussion at the **Riai Aikido O Sensei Revisited Down Under Workshop in March 2019**. Nadeau Shihan's approach is to give students something applicable to daily life and to aid in self-transformation. He is currently ranked 8<sup>th</sup> Dan and was awarded the title of Shihan by Moriteru Ueshiba, grandson of the founder of Aikido, O Sensei.



Accompanying Nadeau Shihan from USA is **Richard Moon Sensei (6<sup>th</sup> Dan)** who has authored several books, videos and audio-programs on extraordinary performance, including, *The Power of Extraordinary Listening*, *Aikido in Three Easy Lessons* and *The Aiki Mastery Audio CDs*. Richard Moon Sensei is the founder of the Art of Extraordinary Listening, and partnered with Christopher Thorsen in *Quantum Edge*. He is a personal coach and has provided consultation, coaching and training to leading edge organisations including Chevron, Apple, Motorola and Hyatt Hotels. A skilled mediator, he has been involved in international peace-building as a senior associate with The Nautilus Institute for Security and Sustainability, as well as having worked in Cyprus and Bosnia.
